JUST A FEW THINGS TO HELP ALL ENJOY THEIR HOLIDAY AT ARALUEN

- **ARALUEN PILLOWS** please do not remove from the bedrooms. The sheets on the beds are to be used as mattress protectors only. If you have forgotten to bring linen we do have some for hire for a fee.
- **NOISE:** There is to be **no noise between 9pm - 9am** in the vicinity of the sleeping cabins. Please respect the sleeping habits of others and our neighbors.
- **DAY VISITORS:** Your friends are most welcome to come visit you. Please be aware there is a \$5.00 per person per day fee. You are responsible to make them aware of all these rules and any other newsletter conditions we may add. Campers staying have first preference for any equipment that is on site.
- **PUSH BIKES SCOOTERS ETC:** **Bikes MUST NOT be ridden on the footpaths.** Protective helmets and footwear are to be worn at all times. It is one way traffic only around past the office and house, this operates as does a round about on the street (for cars also). Bikes etc are not to be left in front of door ways or on footpaths, they may be stored near a tree or on the grass, and must never block the walkway of other people on camp. Camp staff will take bikes away if rules are broken. This is done for the care and safety of all in camp.
- **PETS:** Sorry no pets allowed, guide dogs welcome.
- **CARS:** **The speed limit on camp is walking pace** for the safety of all on site.
- **UPPER ROOM:** This is the room between Ensuite rooms 8 & 9 so noise must be kept to a minimum. This room is reserved for quiet chatting or reading, no music or board games are to be in this room either. Please reserve all noisy games and conversation for the main hall. **There is to be no food or drink in this room.**
- **DVD/VIDEO:** Only G Rated videos/DVD'S may be watched in the morning until 9am. Use of the DVD/Video machine only with Camp Management permission between 9am and 6pm. G/PG rated movies are permitted between 6pm until 9pm; later night viewing will be at the discretion of you, the parents and with consultation with all other adults in the hall. It is the responsibility of those watching(or their parents) to make sure the chairs are put back where they belong and the floor and hall is left clean and tidy for other.
- **BLUE PAYPHONE:** If the blue phone in the hall rings and it is a message for someone who is not on camp at the time, please take a message and leave under their table number. A list of names and Room numbers will be next to the phone for this purpose. It is most important that you leave your table numbers visible at all times in case you need to be contacted for any reason. If your friends or family need to contact you please give them the following number as that is the blue phone number 03 5263 1446. If messages come to the office at night they will be delivered the next morning, unless they are urgent.
- **ESKYS:** Sorry, no eskys are to be left in the cool room or fridges; they will be removed by camp staff.
- **CLEANING:** It is your responsibility to keep your little area of Araluen clean and tidy, please sweep, or vacuum and wipe down your tables and floor areas when necessary. **If you use it, please wash it.** Let's all try and keep Araluen clean for all to enjoy. Kitchen Equipment including all bench surfaces you are using **MUST** be washed/wiped as soon as possible to allow others to use them.
- **SUPERVISION:** Parents/guardians are responsible for the behavior and supervision of the children under their care at all times.
- **KITCHEN:** **Adults only for safety reasons.** Your children may help with washing up. Araluen will be supplying tea towels and wash cloths and a roll of cling wrap for all to use. Please scrape down and clean the BBQ as soon as you have finished using it. Don't leave the BBQ on for another group to use.
- **BREAKAGES:** Please inform camp staff ASAP if you have any breakages so they can be fixed or replaced. **If you break it, you pay for it.**
- **SPORTS GEAR:** Look in the sports cage. All sports equipment must be returned immediately after use.

If you do have an issue with somebody's behavior on camp, can I suggest if possible initially approach **them** and explain your concern in a **gentle** way and I'm sure an understanding will be made.
